## Member Services

The Michigan Campus Compact fulfills our mission to promote the education and commitment of Michigan college and university students to become engaged citizens through offering comprehensive member services that give additional opportunities to members and promotes the civic mission of Higher Education.

### ***Grants***

MCC has provides grants to campuses, individuals and programs to support community service, service-learning and civic engagement on member campuses. In 13 years, MCC has given over 1.3 million dollars in grants to campuses.

### ***Site Visits and Consultant Services***

The MCC staff consults with member institutions on plans to strengthen or expand its community service, service-learning or civic engagement programs. Staff can be requested to visit campus for specific events and/or is available for site visits on a regular basis.

### ***Programs***

MCC offers events and programs to provide professional development, leadership and recognize campuses and individuals to grow service and civic education programs. Programs and events include:

#### ***Institute on Service-Learning***

This two day annual conference promotes the benefit of service-learning, allows participants to discuss individual and institutional support for service-learning, highlights model service-learning programs, and challenges participants to engaging students to be civically involved.

#### ***Student Civic Engagement Campaign***

This campaign will engage campuses and students on many levels of dialogue and opportunity to be come public citizens, with the goal of students taking action for social issues of concern.

#### ***Service Leadership Camp***

This three-day weekend camp experience challenges students and their advisors to work on developing community service and service-learning goals for their campuses and gain valuable knowledge and training on how to develop campus and community based service activities.

### ***Outstanding Student Service Awards***

Annually MCC honors undergraduate and graduate students from member campuses across the state for their outstanding commitment and contributions in the areas of community service, service-learning and civic engagement

#### ***Faculty/Staff Community Service-Learning Awards***

MCC annually recognizes faculty and staff who engage or influence students to be involved in community service or service-learning through modeling, influencing, institutionalizing or instructing. Recipients are recognized during the annual Institute on Service-Learning.

#### ***Colloquiums/Special Events***

Throughout the year, MCC sponsors and partners with campuses or organizations to address changing trends, needs and thinking around community service, service-learning and civic engagement for college students and their campuses.

### ***Resource Library***

MCC's Resource Library is a statewide clearinghouse, providing a variety of academic technical, and practical resources to member institutions. Publications or information can be requested by contacting MCC.

### ***Networking and Development Opportunities***

Committee meetings, seminars and workshops are scheduled throughout the year to facilitate the discussion of ideas. MCC manages Listservs for and convenes meetings of the four membership constituencies: Faculty, Staff, Presidents, and Students.
